



WHITE WINES

San Giorgio Pinot Grigio Bottle £19.50
Breganze, Italy

A vibrant Pinot Grigio that offers much more character and class than some. Showing citrus fruit flavours and subtle floral aromas with good acidity making a refreshing wine.

Devil's Creek Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc Bottle £22.50
New Zealand

Made by the multi award winning Foley Family Wines this wine bursts with passion fruit, gooseberry and peach flavours. This is exactly why the world has fallen in love with New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc.

Quinta de Azevedo, Vinho Verde Bottle £23.50
Portugal

Aromas of tropical fruits, citrus and white flowers. A lively and stimulating wine, with good acidity, hints of spritz and bubble, and a concentrated, fresh finish.

Lorgeril Chardonnay, Les Coteaux Bottle £27
South of France

Powerful aromas of pineapple, vanilla and fresh exotic fruit throughout the palate. Rich and rounded and beautifully well balanced.

ROSÉ WINES

Ormilles Rosé Bottle £19.50
Côtes de Provence, France

A light and dry rosé with strawberry and red cherry flavours, plus more subtle flavours of watermelon and nectarine. Soft acidity and delicate juiciness make for a refreshed palate.

CHAMPAGNE

Pol Roger Réserve, Champagne Bottle £60
France

Pol Roger is perhaps best known as Winston Churchill's favourite Champagne! The House remains family-owned and has a reputation for producing Champagnes of finesse and elegance; one of the very best non-vintage cuvées on the market.

RED WINES

Beauté du Sud Malbec Bottle £19.50
South of France

This modern Malbec echoes both the Old World rusticity of Southern France, and the inky fruitiness found in the Malbecs of Argentina.

Three Realms Pinot Noir Bottle £22
Romania

Romania may not be the first place you think of when you are looking to drink a Pinot Noir but this has all the classic bright red fruit flavours and spicy notes you would expect.

Pavillion des Trois Arches Merlot Bottle £23.50
South of France

Deep ruby red in colour with aromas of berries and sweet spice. The palate is medium-bodied, smooth and rich with a good depth of flavour.

Emilio Moro Bottle £28.50
Ribera del Duero, Spain

Full-bodied with real intensity on the palate; layers of concentrated blackberry, toasted herbs, smoke and vanilla. Châteauneuf-du-Pape,

SPARKLING WINE

Prosecco Corte Alta Bottle £26
Italy

A fresh, frothy wine with medium acidity and lots of accessible pear and peach fruit, without being too heavy or alcoholic.

Chapel Down Brut Bottle £45
England

Chapel Down are one of the biggest and best producers of wine in southern England. Rich yet refreshing with fine bubbles that wrap around all corners of the mouth.

Chapel Down Rosé Brut Bottle £50
England

Classic Pinot Noir nose of strawberry and raspberry with a splash of creaminess. The palate gives ripe berry and rhubarb flavours and clean finish with perfectly balanced acidity.
